COURSE DESCRIPTION

Introduction to ecclesiology: biblical and historical perspectives. Attention will be given to the development of the church's self-understanding as the people of God and to a range of approaches to ministry and sacraments.

- 1) Identify the development of Biblical themes about the people of God.
- 2) Critically assess Christian statements on the nature of the Church in historical and cultural context.
- 3) Critically assess major views on ministry and sacrament for their appropriateness in the modern world.
