COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course builds on the topics and spiritual disciplines introduced in 401 Formation. The focus is on developing approaches to life and ministry which will help to maintain balance, sustainability and growth in ourselves and others. The term "ministry" is used here in the broad sense of employing our gifts and our time for God's service, whatever our context.
