## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Pastoral approaches to significant life crises, including experiences of loss, death and dying, getting married, divorce, alcoholism, mild depression, past hurts. Developmental issues.

#### **LEARNING OUTCOMES**

On completion of 513.715 students should

- 1. Analyse and discuss a range of ways in which a Christian carer may offer help in some of life's crisis situations (developmental crises, relational and emotional crises).
- 2. Have developed and demonstrated an ability to research and critically analyse pastoral issues and their contributing factors, including the skills of analysis, synthesis, persuasive presentation and practical application.
- 3. Demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the value of, and methods for proactive *preventive* preparation for the challenges of life's crises / turning points.
- 4. Be able to apply "whole-person caring" principles to life's crises, with a critical understanding of the theoretical undergirding of various therapeutic approaches, based on current literature.
- 5. Reflect critically on some of their own *personal* crises, problems and challenges, and know ways in which they can grow through these.
