## **Course Description:**

An overview of the history of evangelism and evangelistic methods. An analysis of the current evangelism scene, with a particular emphasis on how evangelism needs to be tailored to the mindset and presuppositions of contemporary society and trends (e.g. postmodernism, generation X, etc.) A survey of possible future trends in evangelism based on current research in the area.

## **Learning Outcomes:**

At the end of the course students should be able to:

- 1. Describe and evaluate a number of evangelistic methods used across history and discuss what they may have to offer to thinking around future evangelistic strategy.
- 2. Discuss the future contexts of evangelism as they seem to be emerging and offer considered ideas on strategies that might be adopted for evangelism.
- 3. Engage with the question of what an effective communication of the gospel for New Zealanders might require and look like in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
