### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This foundational course introduces counselling as a therapeutic relational engagement that finds its context, and its goal, in knowledge of God and humanity drawn from the story of Christ. From this critical standpoint it engages with a broad range of counselling theories and models of practice.

#### **LEARNING OUTCOMES:**

- 1. Describe a broad knowledge of what it means to be a person, relating this to the triune nature of God and the story of God's engagement with the world.
- 2. Discuss a range of explanations about the nature and intention of counselling.
- 3. Describe the major contemporary streams of counselling, including their views of persons, theories of change, and therapeutic strategies.
- 4. Discuss and compare appropriates method and procedures for counselling in the light of the understanding that humans are persons-in-relation.
