COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Course is an introductory study of the grammar and vocabulary of Biblical Hebrew, and its application in translation and exegesis. The course is based on Chapters 1-19, 36 of Gary D. Pratico and Miles V. Van Pelt, *Basics of Biblical Hebrew*, Second edition (Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 2008).

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of this course students should be able to:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of the vocabulary in the specified lessons of Pratico and Van Pelt.
2. Read Hebrew script with its Masoretic pointing.
3. Show familiarity with the key points of Hebrew grammar covered in the lessons covered.
4. Utilise the knowledge gained to parse Hebrew words and translate simple passages of Biblical Hebrew into English.
5. Indicate an awareness of the exegetical value of the linguistic knowledge gained.
