1. Demonstrate knowledge of the vocabulary in the course textbooks
2. Show familiarity with the key points of Greek grammar covered in both 104.515 and 105.615
3. Translate selected passages of NT Greek, and comment on the vocabulary and syntax encountered in those passages
4. Utilise the knowledge gained to parse Greek words and comment on basic and intermediate NT Greek syntax
5. Translate unseen passages of NT Greek into English.
6. Indicate an awareness of the exegetical value of the linguistic knowledge gained.
