**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

During this course you will study the story of God's dealings with creation and humanity. The course will help you understand selected doctrines and themes of the Bible, express them clearly in written English, and discover how they can affect your life.

**LEARNING OUTCOMES:**

At the end of this course, students should be able to:

1. Read sections of the biblical story to discover some Christian doctrines.
2. Read theological texts and extract meaning from them.
3. Describe and explain in acceptable English aspects of the doctrines of God, humankind and sin.
4. Show how the important people, events and movements of God's chosen people fit into the overall Story and the purposes of God for his people.
5. Recognise cultural and personal issues related to the topics studied, and think about biblical responses to them.
6. Recognise and write different types of complex nominal groups often used in abstract/theological texts.
7. Logically write a theological concept using appropriate link words.
