COURSE DESCRIPTION

Traditional and contemporary theologies of the person and work of Christ. Theology of revelation and Scripture.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the end of this course students are expected to

1. Demonstrate a knowledge of highlights in the development of Christology and atonement, including early church positions and contemporary reframing of doctrine,
2. Analyse and evaluate Christology in dialogue with a range of contemporary challenges. These will include some of the following: feminist, postmodern, scientific and cultural perspectives; the challenges of religious plurality.
3. Demonstrate and evaluate a variety of viewpoints about theological method and the reading and interpretation of Scripture.
4. Discuss and critically evaluate the practical outworkings of Christology, revelation and Scripture for mission and church and personal life.
