COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will introduce students to aspects of discipleship through engagement with Scripture, personal reflection, academic enquiry and spiritual exercises. Using the gospels of Matthew and Mark as a basis, topics of both personal and interpersonal spirituality will be explored.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

At the end of this course, students should be able to:

1. Outline selected major aspects of discipleship as illustrated in the gospels and give their response to these.
2. Reflect scripturally on different approaches to a range of topics relating to discipleship, and how these may be personally applied.
3. Write a reflective essay that integrates aspects of the course and personal application.
4. Integrate a range of views on a given topic, assess and present their own opinion.
5. Write in clear, concise English: grammatically correct sentences; well-organised and cohesive paragraphs; accurate spelling.
6. Demonstrate appropriate referencing of Scripture, and of other sources with footnotes and bibliography.
