COURSE DESCRIPTION

Internship courses are designed to equip men and women for effective leadership and ministry in the church and in the world. This Internship course focuses on the management of ministry with specific emphasis on fostering self-awareness around the issue of self-care. Management theory meets practice through the experience of ministry, mentoring, reflective practice, assignments and integrative tutorials.

THE INTERNSHIP PROCESS

The key elements are:

- At least 8 hours per week practical ministry involvement
- Ongoing reflection on ministry and learning
- Fortnightly meetings with your internship mentor
- Fortnightly participation in integrative tutorials
- Completion of written assessments
