COURSE DESCRIPTION

The goal of this course is to investigate the principles and practices of educational leadership and research ways in which this influences the classroom. Teachers need to constantly reflect on the characteristics of effective educational leadership. This course demonstrates emerging leadership skills in the planning, preparation and administration of an orientation camp for the School of Education staff and students.
