### **202.715 Christology Course Outline**

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course explores God's fullest and most complete revelation in Jesus Christ. It explores Christ's person and work through the lens of the Scriptures, the early patristic debates, and Christological developments sourced from the Protestant reformation and wider church traditions. Utilising the insights gained through these explorations, the course develops a systematic understanding of Christ's being and saving work. It concludes by reflecting Christologically on contemporary issues.
