COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course explores the theology and practice of Christian worship, historically and in contemporary settings. Students will engage with a range of liturgical expressions in order to inform the development of a contextualised theology and practice of worship in their own setting.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course the student should be able to:

1. Sketch the development of worship in the biblical tradition and through the historical expressions of the Christian Church.
2. Survey contemporary practices of Christian worship.
3. Prepare a contextualised service of worship that draws on Scripture, tradition, contemporary practice, and liturgical innovation.
4. Plan a theology of worship for their own faith community that seeks to develop its liturgical life.
