COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course explores the theology and practice of Christian worship, historically and in contemporary settings. Students will engage with a range of liturgical expressions in order to inform the development of a contextualised theology and practice of worship in their own setting.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, the student should be able to:

- 1. Summarise the development of worship in the biblical tradition, and through the historical expressions of the Christian Church.
- 2. Evaluate contemporary practices of Christian worship.
- 3. Develop a contextualised service of worship that draws on Scripture, tradition, contemporary practice, and liturgical innovation.
- 4. Formulate a theology of worship for their own faith community that develops its liturgical life.
