COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is an introduction to ecclesiology. The doctrine of the church is explored through the lenses of Scripture, tradition, reason, experience, and culture. Students are encouraged to think theologically about the church and then to investigate how this thinking affects decisions about what the church does. Students are equipped to make critical assessments of ecclesiology based on coherent theological understanding.
